General Rules and Regulations

- Admission to the college is made provisionally at the sole risk and responsibility of the candidate and subject to the approval of GNDU. If approval to the admission is withheld by the competent authority for any reason, the student shall bear the whole responsibility and will not be entitled to any claim from the college.
- A student who is placed under compartment in SSC-II Board Examination can take admission in BA/B.Sc/ B.Com-I provisionally provided she clears her compartment exam by Dec., 2019 otherwise the admission will automatically stand cancelled.
- In migration cases, it is the sole responsibility of the student to fulfil the eligibility criteria of the University. Till the case is cleared by University, the admission will be considered as provisional.

Rules for Leave
